- Toiletries kits*: personal items such as shampoo, soap, toothpaste/toothbrushes.
- Kitchen kits*: pots and pans, tableware, mixing bowls, etc.
- Cleaning supplies kits*: dish soap, laundry detergent, sponges.
- Linens kits: bath towels, sheets, blankets.

The deadline for collecting the items above is January 31, 2022. We will be asking for volunteers to assemble the kits. We will drop them at LSS Refugee Resettlement Office in Milwaukee, WI.
