Immanuel Quilters started assembling, tying and sewing quilts and will continue Thursday mornings at 9am until mid-May. These quilts are donated to Lutheran World Relief for distribution to refugees and others in need throughout the world. Tops for the quilts are made from fabric remnants and the quilt backs are gently used sheets or similar fabric. Fiber fill is purchased for the middle layer. Assembling the quilts is done in the workroom on the second floor of the education wing. Some quilters work at home cutting and sewing together squares for the quilt tops. We welcome all donations of sheets, fabric, and yarn however there are different brands and sizes of needles and some threads are better than others, so we want to purchase those along with the fiberfill.
