Shrove/Fat Tuesday will be on Sunday.

Shrove Tuesday is the religious holiday for which pancake day is patterned. Throughout the Christian world, Shrove Tuesday is a day for feasting, before the 40 days fast of Lent. The name “Shrove Tuesday” comes from the custom of people making their confession, doing penance, and thus being “shriven” or absolved. The tradition of eating pancakes arose from the English custom in which all foods forbidden during Lent, such as fat and eggs, had to be used up so they wouldn’t spoil. Thus, these ingredients were made into cakes, and the day became one of feasting and merrymaking. Mardi Gras, which literally means “Fat Tuesday”, is another form of the Shrove Tuesday holiday which proceeds Ash Wednesday.
