You could include a drawing, a photo, or a recipe, anything that fits into an envelope. 4. Offer up a prayer for the recipient. 5. You may include your mailing address in the letter if you do not wish to remain anonymous. 6. Print and sign the:

7. Mail your letter and signed release form to Dear Friend in Christ, Women of the ELCA, 8765 W Higgins Road, Chicago IL 60631. **Deadline for mailing letters to the churchwide organization is October 15, 2020.** 

When you write to Dear Friend in Christ, your letter will be swapped with a letter from another writer. They will get your letter; you will get their letter. The exchange is anonymous (unless you provide your contact information), so you can share as little or as much information about yourself as you like.

## Godparent(s) Sunday School Program

Dear members of Immanuel Lutheran Church,

Grace and peace to you. Until we return to *regular* worship services, I will lead the Sunday school program instead of Judy Nickolai.

Due to coronavirus, the Sunday school will not be held in the church. Despite this challenge, I believe that our children deserve to receive Christian education to help them to grow in faith. There are different ways to provide Christian education without asking the kids to come to church.

I encourage you to participate in the Godparent (s) Sunday School Program. It is a program pairing Sunday School student with an adult(s) church member designed to build relationships, encourage fellowship, and foster mutual growth in faith through exchanging cards, speaking over the phone, FaceTime, Skype, etc.

Of course, parents should be involved with their child's faith, but it is also essential to have our congregation members engaged. It can help parents feel connected to the church community, strengthen relationships across generations, and, most importantly, help Sunday school students grow in their faith (and many times, the members as well!).

We have nine Sunday school students. I need nine persons or non-couples to be Godparent(s) to one student. I will pair Godparent(s) with a student randomly, and you will work together for two months. After two months, I will assign you another child.

If you feel you are called by God to be part of this ministry, please let me know as soon as you can.
