

IMMANUEL ANNIVERSARY

On December 18, 1949, 75 years ago, the new Immanuel church, located at Seventh and Adams, was dedicated by the president (the bishop title was not used) of the Evangelical Lutheran Church, J.A. Aasgard. The first service in the new sanctuary was held the Sunday before. The congregation had been

worshipping in the basement area (now Fellowship Hall) since September. The cost to the congregation was \$175,000. It was considered the most important event in Immanuel's history. The old church on First and Franklin was sold, torn down and the new owners built a building for an auto parts store. Today it is part of the site for the Eye Clinic of Wisconsin.


